WHAT IS 'FIRST AID AFRICA'?

First Aid Africa is an international partnership, which provides emergency healthcare training in rural communities, where access to healthcare is limited.

In the UK we are a registered charity and our volunteers are trained at British Universities before joining colleagues from across Africa to provide lifesaving skills in the areas where they're needed the most.

The charity is young, at eight years old, but has received financial support from the British Medical Association (BMA), the Scottish Government and 15 partner Universities.

Additionally the charity has benefitted from logistical or material support from the Red Cross, St Andrew's First Aid and St. John Ambulance.



WHAT IS THE "IVP"?

Our 'international volunteering programme' provides an opportunity for those interested in international development to train as First Aid Africa course instructors, before joining our teams in communities across East & Southern Africa.

Instructors are then required to spend at least one month working with our teams in Tanzania, Kenya, Malawi, Uganda or Zambia in order to provide lifesaving training & resources to communities, where access to emergency care is limited.

During this period, our international instructors are supported by experienced expedition leaders and in-country staff.

CASE STUDY

"A STREET MOTORBIKE HAD COLLIDED WITH A PRIVATE CAR. TWO PEOPLE DIED IMMEDIATELY AFTERWARDS.

ONE MAN WAS LYING ON THE STREET.

I USED MY SHIRT TO STOP HIM BLEEDING
AND I TOLD OTHER PEOPLE TO GO AND FIND TRANSPORT SO THAT WE COULD GET HIM TO HOSPITAL. HE HAD LOST SO
MUCH BLOOD FROM HIS LEG, STOMACH AND NOSE.

I HAD RECEIVED TRAINING FROM FIRST AID AFRICA A FEW MONTHS BEFORE THIS ACCIDENT AND I KNEW WHAT TO DO.

WE SAVED A LIFE THAT DAY BUT MANY VILLAGES DO NOT HAVE THIS KNOWLEDGE. MANY VILLAGES DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO A HOSPITAL OR CLINIC NEARBY. FIRST AID EDUCATION IS CRUCIAL."
